## Read Mark 8:27-10:52

1. Outline/list the main events and your observations of their significance.  
(For larger assignments, break the assigned reading down into the smaller sections. Give the verse numbers for each section. Then summarize the section and explain how it is related to the sections before and after.)
2. List any questions you have or anything you think needs further study.
3. Answer the following questions:
  - a. Who did people think Jesus was? How did the disciples answer the question “Who do you say that I am?”
  - b. What did Jesus teach the disciples in 8:31? How was that different from what Peter expected? Why did Jesus rebuke Peter?
  - c. What did Jesus want His disciples to do (8:34-35)?
  - d. What did God say to the disciples (9:7)? Where else in Mark have you read a similar statement?
  - e. How did Jesus explain what it meant to be great?
  - f. How did Jesus answer the question about divorce?
  - g. When the disciples were astonished and dismayed at Jesus’ words, how did He encourage them (10:26-27)?
  - h. How did Jesus say He would die (10:33-34)?
  - i. How did Jesus respond to James and John’s request?
