V. 1

πνευματικοῖς

having to do with the divine Spirit, caused by or filled with the divine Spirit, pertaining/corresponding to the divine Spirit, “stands in contrast to ψυχικός ἄνθρωπος of vs. 14. The latter is a person who has nothing more than an ordinary human soul; the former possesses the divine πνεῦμα, not beside his natural human soul, but in place of it; this enables the person to penetrate the divine mysteries” Spirit-filled people

σαρκίνοις

pertaining to being material or belonging to the physical realm, material, physical, human, fleshly, of humanity at a disappointing level of behavior or character, (merely) human, pertaining to behavior which is typical of human nature, but with special focus upon more base physical desires, worldly, base

V. 2

γάλα

milk, fig. of elementary Christian instruction
milk, ‘I fed you milk, not solid food’

ἐπότισα

AAI1sg.

fr. ποτιζω

make it possible for someone to drink, give to drink, in imagery, give someone milk to drink
to cause to drink, to give to drink

βρῶμα

that which is eaten, food, esp. solid food, in imagery
any type of solid food, particularly meat, solid food, meat, flesh, ‘I gave you milk to drink, not solid food’

V. 3

ὅπου

marker of cause or reason, in so far as, since
marker of cause or reason, with special reference to a set of relevant circumstances,
whereas, since, ‘for whereas there is jealousy and strife among you’

ζήλος

intense negative feelings over another’s achievements or success, jealousy, envy
a particular strong feeling of resentment and jealousy against someone, envy, jealousy, resentment

ἔρις

engagement in rivalry, especially with reference to positions taken in a matter, strife, discord, contention

conflict resulting from rivalry and discord, to express differences of opinion, with at least some measure of antagonism or hostility, 'when there is jealousy and strife among you, doesn't this prove that you are people of this world?'

V. 4

ἄνθρωποι

a member of the human race, with focus on limitations and weaknesses, a human being, of status, in a human way, from a human standpoint emphasizes the inferiority of human beings in comparison with God

a human being, person, individual
