## V. 3

γινώσκομεν                      PAlpl                      fr. γινωσκω  
to arrive at a knowledge of something, know, know about  
to possess information about, to know, to know about, to have knowledge of, to be acquainted with, acquaintance

ἐγνώκαμεν                      PfAlpl                      fr. γινωσκω  
to have come to the knowledge of, have come to know, know  
to learn to know a person through direct personal experience, implying a continuity of relationship, to know, to become acquainted with, to be familiar with

ἐντολὰς  
a mandate or ordinance, command, of commands given by divine authorities, of the precepts of Jesus  
that which is authoritatively commanded, commandment, order

τηρῶμεν                      PAS1pl                      fr. τηρεω  
to persist in obedience, keep, observe, fulfill, pay attention to, especially of law and teaching  
to continue to obey orders or commandments, to obey, to keep commandments, obedience

Ἔγνοκα                      PfAl1sg                      fr. γινωσκω  
see above

τηρῶν                      PAPtcpMSN                      fr. τηρεω  
see above

ψεύστης  
liar, one who speaks what is not true  
one who utters falsehoods and lies, liar

ἀλήθεια  
the content of what is true, truth, especially of the content of Christianity as the ultimate truth  
the content of that which is true and thus in accordance with what actually happened, truth

## V. 5

τηρῆ                      PAS3sg                      fr. τηρεω  
see above

ἀληθῶς

corresponding to what is really so, truly, in truth, really, actually, 'is truly perfected'  
pertaining to being real and not imaginary, real, really, true, truly

τετελείωται

PfPI3sg

fr. τελειωω

to overcome or supplant an imperfect state of things by one that is free from objection, bring to an end, bring to its goal/accomplishment, make perfect, of love being perfected  
to make perfect in the moral sense, to make perfect, to perfect, causing perfection, 'truly in this person the love of God is made perfect'

## V. 6

μένειν

PAInf

fr. μενω

remain, stay, in transferred sense, of someone who does not leave a certain realm or sphere,  
remain, continue, abide, of Christians in their relation to Christ  
to continue in an activity or state, to continue, to remain in, to keep on

ὀφείλει

PAI3sg

fr. ὀφειλω

to be under obligation to meet certain social or moral expectations, owe  
to be obligatory in view of some moral or legal requirement, ought, to be under obligation

περιεπάτησεν

AAI3sg

fr. περιπατεω

περιπατεῖν

PAInf

fr. περιπατεω

to conduct one's life, comport oneself, behave, live as habit of conduct  
to live or behave in a customary manner, with possible focus on continuity of action, to live, to behave, to go about doing

οὕτως

referring to what precedes, in this manner, thus, so, with καθως 'just as... so...'  
so, thus, in this way
