ἀπόστολος

certain believers with a special function as God's envoys. One who proclaimed the Gospel. Special messenger of God chosen and commissioned for particular function.

ἐκλεκτοῖς

being selected, chosen. Of those whom God has chosen from the generality of mankind and drawn to Himself.

παρεπιδήμοις

staying a while in a foreign place, sojourning, residing temporarily, stranger, foreigner, resident alien. A person who for a period of time lives in a place which is not his normal residence; alien, stranger, temporary alien

διασπορᾶς

the place in which the dispersed are found, dispersion, diaspora, fig. of Christians who live in dispersion in the world, far from their heavenly home
the region or area in which persons have been scattered, region in which people are scattered

V. 2

πρόγνωσιν

predetermination – of God's omniscient wisdom and intention. To know beforehand, to know already, to have foreknowledge. That which is known ahead of time.

ἀγιασμῶ

personal dedication to the interests of the deity, holiness, consecration, sanctification. The state of being made holy.
To dedicate to the service of and to loyalty to deity. Consecration – suggesting resulting moral behavior, the emphasis is not upon a manner of life, but upon religious activity and observances which reflect one's dedication or consecration to God.

ὑπακοήν

state of being in compliance, obedience; listen and follow instructions. With objective genitive – obedience to Christ. To obey on the basis of having paid attention to something

ῥαντισμὸν

sprinkling, blood that is sprinkled for atonement, cf. Heb 12:24, Num 19:9; symbolizing purification

πληθυνθείη

APO3sg.

fr. πληθυνω

be multiplied, grow greatly, increase;
