Διο inferential conjunction- therefore, for this reason. “With the connective particle διο of v. 13, Peter shifts from reflection on the gospel his readers have received and the eschatological hope this gospel has given them, to the ethical responsibilities they now have as a result.” WBC p.52

αναζωοσαμενοι AMPtcpMPN coordinate circumstances Glee. p. 58- imperative expression- middle voice take action upon self. possibly referring to action before leading verb.

τας οσφυας της διανοιας ‘υμων - DO of αναζ... whole phrase is idiom- one semantic unit meaning “prepare your mind for action”

νηφοντες PAPtcpMPN – coordinate circumstances Glee. p. 58 – imperative expression.

τελειως adverb mod. ελπίζω or (slight possibility) νηφο...

ελπίζω AAImp2pl leading verb imperative Aorist tense poss. sig. once and for all decision.

επι την χαριν shows basis and object of hope

φερομενην PPPtcpFSA mod χαριν passive- given not taken. present tense- peculiar with time reference εν αποκαλυπει Ιησου Χριστου - present with future meaning- BDF §323 (1)- “Although it can have a future force, it is used here in keeping with the writers conviction that the object of their hope is already virtually within the readers grasp.” - Kelly

‘υμιν IO of φερο..

εν αποκαλυπει Ιησου Χριστου – gives time reference to φερο...

‘ως “introduces characteristic qualities of a person” giving standard for comparison. cf. 2:2

τεκνα ‘υπακοης – Semitic expression = obedient children “ The use of the word “children” or “sons” with an abstract noun is a widely recognized Semitic idiom referring to people who are characterized by the quality which that noun represents.” WBC p. 56

συσχηματιζομενοι PM/PPtcpMPN coordinate circumstance Glee. p. 58 - imperative expression

ταις επιθυμιας agency of συσχ...

προτερον mod. επιθυμιας “former lusts”

εν τη αγνοια mod. επιθυμιας “which you had when you were ignorant” causal as well as temporal aspects

αλλα strong adversative btwn. συσχ... and γενη...

κατα τον 'αγιον – “of the norm, of similarity, homogeneity, according to , in accordance with, in conformity with, corresponding to... to introduce the norm that governs someth.” BAG 408 II5αα “it can also stand simply with the acc. of the pers. according to whose will, pleasure or manner someth. occurs.” “like the holy one who called you.”

καλεσαντα 'υμας – AAPtcpMSA adj. mod τον 'αγιον “the one who called you.”

αυτοι subject for emphasis

'αγιοι - predicate nom. mod. αυτοι

εν παση αναστροφη mod. γενηθητε describing when and how to be holy.

γενηθητε APdepImp2pl “be” or “become”

γεγραπται PfPI3sg it is written - disclosure formula for citing scripture.

'Αγιοι - predicate nom. of εσεσθε
