

## 1 Peter 3:17-22

17 It is better while doing good, if the will of God determines, to suffer, than while doing evil. 18 For Christ also suffered as a sin offering, once and for all – the righteous One in place of unrighteous ones – in order to bring you to God. Being put to death in the flesh, but being made alive in the Spirit. 19 By Whom, having gone, He proclaimed to the spirits under guard 20 They disobeyed back then, when the patience of God continued waiting in the days of Noah, while the ark was being constructed. Into which a few – that is eight souls – were saved through water. 21 This also corresponds to baptism, which now saves you – not the removing of dirt from the flesh, but the pledge/request to God of a good conscience through the resurrection of Jesus Christ 22 – Who is at the right hand of God, having gone into heaven. Angels and authorities and powers are in submission to Him.
