to look forward to something with implication of confidence about something coming to pass,
hope, hope for

mouth, 'speak face to face'
the position of persons facing one another and engaging in discussion, face to face, person, to
person

χαρὰ

the experience of gladness
a state of joy and gladness, joy, gladness, great happiness

πεπληρωμένη

PfPPtcpFSN

fr. πληρωω

to bring to completion that which was already begun, complete, finish, 'joy that is made

Ἀσπάζεται

PM/Pdep3sg

fr. ἀσπάζομαι

to engage in hospitable recognition of another, greet, welcome, greetings to someone or
remember me to someone, send greetings
to employ certain set phrases as a part of the process of greeting, whether communicated directly
or indirectly, to greet, to send greetings

ἀδελφῆς

a person or thing viewed as a sister in relation to another entity, sister, metaphorically, of a close
relationship of similar communities

a close female associate of a group with well-defined membership (in the NT referring specifically to fellow believers in Christ), fellow believer, sister in Christ, sister in the faith

ἐκλεκτῆς

pertaining to being selected, chosen, of those whom God has chosen from the generality of mankind and drawn to himself, of a Christian assembly or congregation, cf. v. 1
to choose, choice, that which has been chosen, chosen
