to hold a view or have an opinion with regard to something, to hold a view, to have an opinion, to consider, to regard

γράψαι

AAInf

fr. γράφω

to express thought in writing, of correspondence, write to someone  
to write

θέλω

PAI1sg

fr. θέλω

to have a desire for something, wish to have, desire, want  
to desire to have or experience something, to desire, to want, to wish

μέλανος

ink, cf. 2 Cor 3:3

black, dark color

καλάμου

reed pen

a reed especially cut for making marks with ink on writing material, pen

ἐλπίζω

PAI1sg

fr. ἐλπίζω

to look forward to something with implication of confidence about something coming to pass, hope, hope for  
to expect, with the implication of some benefit, to expect, to hope

εὐθέως

at once, immediately

a point of time immediately subsequent to a previous point of time, immediately, right away

ἰδεῖν

AAInf

fr. εἶδον

see, to show an interest in, look after, visit, visit someone

to go to see a person on the basis of friendship and with helpful intent, to visit, to go to see, cf. Heb 13:23, Rom 15:24, Mt 25:43

στόμα

mouth, 'speak face to face'

ἀσπάζονται

PM/PdepI3pl

fr. ἀσπάζομαι

to engage in hospitable recognition of another, greet, welcome, greetings to someone or remember me to someone, send greetings

to employ certain set phrases as a part of the process of greeting, whether communicated directly or indirectly, to greet, to send greetings

φίλοι

one who is on intimate terms or in close association with another, friend, suggesting a communal association
