denoting relationship to something, with respect to, in relation to, cf. Eph 6:21, Phil 1:12
marker of a specific element bearing a relation to something else, in relation to, with regard to

γνωρίσει

FAI3sg

fr. γνωρίζω

to cause information to become known, make known, reveal, cf. Eph 6:21, Jn 15:15
to cause information to be known by someone, to make known

ἀγαπητός

pertaining to one who is dearly loved, dear, beloved, prized, valued, cf v. 9, 14, 1:7, Eph 6:21

pertaining to one who or that which is loved, object of one's affection, one who is loved, beloved, dear

πιστός

pertaining to being worthy of belief or trust, trustworthy, faithful, dependable, inspiring trust/faith, reliable persons, 'Paul honors his co-workers with πιστος as a designation, cf. v. 9, 1 Cor 4:17, Eph 6:21

pertaining to being trusted, faithful, trustworthy, dependable, reliable

διάκονος

one who serves as an intermediary in a transaction, agent, intermediary, courier, cf. 1:7, 23, 25, Eph 6:21, 1 Tim 4:6

a person who renders service, servant

σύνδουλος

a subordinate in total obedience to a ruler, slave, of a relationship to the heavenly κυριος, Paul designates certain Christians as his συνδουλοι, cf 1:7

one who is a fellow slave or a slave alongside another slave, fellow slave

ἔπεμψα

AAI1sg

fr. πέμπω

to dispatch someone, whether human or transcendent being, usually for purposes of communication, send, cf. Eph 6:22, Phil 2:25, Titus 3:12

to cause someone to depart for a particular purpose, to send, cf. Phil 2:19

αὐτὸ τοῦτο

intensive marker, setting an item off from everything else through emphasis and contrast, self, with attention directed to a certain person or thing to the exclusion of other lexical units, so that αὐτός can almost take on demonstrative sense, αὐτο τοῦτο just this, the very same thing, cf. 2 Cor 7:11, Gal 2:11, Phil 1:6, Rom 9:17, 13:6 2 Cor 5:5, Eph 6:22
pertaining to that which is identical to something, same

περὶ

to denote the object or person to which an activity or inward process refers or relates, about, concerning, with regard to, with reference to, in relation to, cf 1 Cor 7:37, Acts 15:2
markers of general content, whether of a discourse or mental activity, concerning, about, of

παρακαλέσῃ

PAS3sg

fr. παρακαλέω

to instill someone with courage or cheer, comfort, encourage, cheer up, cf. 2:2, Eph 6:22, 2 Thes 2:17
to cause someone to be encouraged or consoled, either by verbal or non-verbal means, to encourage, to console

σὺν

marker of accompaniment and association, with focus on association in activity
a marker of an associative relation, often involving joint participation in some activity, with, together with

πιστῶ

marker denoting origin, cause, motive, reason, from, of, to denote origin as to family, race, city, people, district, etc.
a marker of the source from which someone or something is physically or psychologically derived, from

a position or point that is relatively near, here, in the sense in this place
a position relatively near the speaker, writer, or viewpoint person, here
