Genesis- “Beginnings” Heb. “In the Beginning”

Author:

Anonymous, attributed to Moses

Occasion and Purpose:

Written at the Exodus for the new nation to understand their identity, heritage and responsibility.

A polemic against false Gods, showing that the God of Israel is the one true God.

Themes:

1. God’s good creation
2. Universal sinfulness
3. Inability for humans to save themselves
4. God’s sovereign control
5. God’s grace
6. Promise (made and tested)
7. Election
8. Covenant

Summary:

The story of beginnings. The beginning of creation, sin, man's rebellion against God and God's plan of redemption. The Genesis story focuses on the life of Abraham and his family. God called Abraham and blessed him and his family. His descendants Isaac and Jacob also walked with God. God miraculously provided for Jacob’s family and the story ends with them in Egypt, prepared for the next phase of God's salvation in history.
