ἔχοντες παρρησίαν

Ephesians 3:12 in whom we have boldness and access with confidence through our faith in him.

Hebrews 4:16 Let us then approach the throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need.

Hebrews 3:6 but Christ is faithful over God's house as a son. And we are his house if indeed we hold fast our confidence and our boasting in our hope.

Hebrews 10:35 Therefore do not throw away your confidence, which has a great reward.

1 John 2:28 And now, little children, abide in him, so that when he appears we may have confidence and not shrink from him in shame at his coming.

Philemon 1:8 Accordingly, though I am bold enough in Christ to command you to do what is required

Hebrews 6:19-20 We have this as a sure and steadfast anchor of the soul, a hope that enters into the inner place behind the curtain, where Jesus has gone as a forerunner on our behalf,

Hebrews 9:3 Behind the second curtain was a second section called the Most Holy Place,

Hebrews 9:6-9 These preparations having thus been made, the priests go regularly into the first section, performing their ritual duties, But only the high priest entered the inner room, and that only once a year, and never without blood, which he offered for himself and for the sins the people had committed in ignorance. This is an illustration for the present time, indicating that the gifts and sacrifices being offered were not able to clear the conscience of the worshiper.

Hebrews 9:12 he entered once for all into the holy places, not by means of the blood of goats and calves but by means of his own blood, thus securing an eternal redemption.

Hebrews 9:25 Nor was it to offer himself repeatedly, as the high priest enters the holy places every year with blood not his own,

Hebrews 13:11 For the bodies of those animals whose blood is brought into the holy places by the high priest as a sacrifice for sin are burned outside the camp.

ἐν τῷ αἵματι Ἰησοῦ

Hebrews 9:7 but into the second only the high priest goes, and he but once a year, and not without taking blood, which he offers for himself and for the unintentional sins of the people.

Hebrews 9:12-14 he entered once for all into the holy places, not by means of the blood of goats and calves but by means of his own blood, thus securing an eternal redemption. For if the blood of goats and bulls, and the sprinkling of defiled persons with the ashes of a heifer, sanctify for the purification of the flesh, how much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without blemish to God, purify our conscience from dead works to serve the living God.

Hebrews 9:18-22 Therefore not even the first covenant was inaugurated without blood. For when every commandment of the law had been declared by Moses to all the people, he took the blood of calves and goats, with water and scarlet wool and hyssop, and sprinkled both the book itself and all the people, saying, "This is the blood of the covenant that God commanded for you." And in the same way he sprinkled with the blood both the tent and all the vessels used in worship. Indeed, under the law almost everything is purified with blood, and without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness of sins.

Hebrews 9:25 Nor was it to offer himself repeatedly, as the high priest enters the holy places every year with blood not his own,

Hebrews 10:4 For it is impossible for the blood of bulls and goats to take away sins.

Hebrews 12:24 and to Jesus, the mediator of a new covenant, and to the sprinkled blood that speaks a better word than the blood of Abel.

Hebrews 7:27 Unlike the other high priests, he does not need to offer sacrifices day after day, first for his own sins, and then for the sins of the people. He sacrificed for their sins once for all when he offered himself.

Ephesians 2:13 But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ.

v. 20

Hebrews 9:18 Therefore not even the first covenant was inaugurated without blood.

ὁδὸν πρόσφατον καὶ ζῶσαν

Hebrews 9:8 By this the Holy Spirit indicates that the way into the holy places is not yet opened as long as the first section is still standing

John 14:6 Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.

Hebrews 4:12 For the word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart.

Hebrews 7:16 who has become a priest, not on the basis of a legal requirement concerning bodily descent, but by the power of an indestructible life.

Hebrews 7:25 Consequently, he is able to save to the uttermost those who draw near to God through him, since he always lives to make intercession for them.

Hebrews 10:31 It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God.

Hebrews 5:7 In the days of his flesh

Colossians 1:22 he has now reconciled in his body of flesh by his death, in order to present you holy and blameless and above reproach before him

Hebrews 2:17 Therefore he had to be made like his brothers in every respect, so that he might become a merciful and faithful high priest in the service of God, to make propitiation for the sins of the people.

Hebrews 4:14-15 Since then we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus, the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession. 15 For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin.

Hebrews 5:1 For every high priest chosen from among men is appointed to act on behalf of men in relation to God, to offer gifts and sacrifices for sins.

Hebrews 5:7-10 In the days of his flesh, Jesus offered up prayers and supplications, with loud cries and tears, to him who was able to save him from death, and he was heard because of his reverence. 8 Although he was a son, he learned obedience through what he suffered. 9 And being made perfect, he became the source of eternal salvation to all who obey him, 10 being designated by God a high priest after the order of Melchizedek.

Hebrews 6:20 where Jesus has gone as a forerunner on our behalf, having become a high priest forever after the order of Melchizedek.

Hebrews 7:16 who has become a priest, not on the basis of a legal requirement concerning bodily descent, but by the power of an indestructible life.

Hebrews 7:23-28 The former priests were many in number, because they were prevented by death from continuing in office, 24 but he holds his priesthood permanently, because he continues forever. 25 Consequently, he is able to save to the uttermost those who draw near to God through him, since he always lives to make intercession for them. 26 For it was indeed fitting that we should have such a high priest, holy, innocent, unstained, separated from sinners, and exalted above the heavens. 27 He has no need, like those high priests, to offer sacrifices daily, first for his own sins and then for those of the people, since he did this once for all when he offered up himself. 28 For the law appoints men in their weakness as high priests, but the word of the oath, which came later than the law, appoints a Son who has been made perfect forever.

Hebrews 8:1-2 Now the point in what we are saying is this: we have such a high priest, one who is seated at the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in heaven, 2 a minister in the holy places, in the true tent that the Lord set up, not man.

Hebrews 8:6 But as it is, Christ has obtained a ministry that is as much more excellent than the old as the covenant he mediates is better, since it is enacted on better promises.

Hebrews 9:11 But when Christ appeared as a high priest of the good things that have come, then through the greater and more perfect tent (not made with hands, that is, not of this creation)

Hebrews 9:15 Therefore he is the mediator of a new covenant, so that those who are called may receive the promised eternal inheritance, since a death has occurred that redeems them from the transgressions committed under the first covenant.

Hebrews 10:11-14 And every priest stands daily at his service, offering repeatedly the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins. 12 But when Christ had offered for all time a single sacrifice for sins, he sat down at the right hand of God, 13 waiting from that time until his enemies should be made a footstool for his feet. 14 For by a single offering he has perfected for all time those who are being sanctified.

Hebrews 12:24 and to Jesus, the mediator of a new covenant, and to the sprinkled blood that speaks a better word than the blood of Abel.

Hebrews 13:11-12 For the bodies of those animals whose blood is brought into the holy places by the high priest as a sacrifice for sin are burned outside the camp. 12 So Jesus also suffered outside the gate in order to sanctify the people through his own blood.

ἐπὶ τὸν οἶκον τοῦ θεοῦ

1 Timothy 3:15 if I delay, you may know how one ought to behave in **the household of God**, which is the church of the living God, a pillar and buttress of the truth.

Hebrews 3:6 but Christ is faithful **over God's house as a son**. And **we are his house** if indeed we hold fast our confidence and our boasting in our hope.

v. 22

προσερχώμεθα

Hebrews 7:19 (for the law made nothing perfect); but on the other hand, a better hope is introduced, through which **we draw near to God**.

Hebrews 7:25 Consequently, he is able to save to the uttermost those who **draw near to God through him**, since he always lives to make intercession for them.

Hebrews 10:1 For since the law has but a shadow of the good things to come instead of the true form of these realities, it can never, by the same sacrifices that are continually offered every year, make perfect **those who draw near**.

Hebrews 11:6 And without faith it is impossible to please him, for whoever would **draw near to God** must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who seek him.

Hebrews 12:18 For **you have not come** to what may be touched, a blazing fire and darkness and gloom and a tempest

Hebrews 12:22 But **you have come** to Mount Zion and to the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to innumerable angels in festal gathering

James 4:8 **Draw near to God**, and **he will draw near to you**. Cleanse your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded.

Ephesians 2:18 For through him **we both have access in one Spirit to the Father**.

Ephesians 6:5 Bondservants, obey your earthly masters with fear and trembling, **with a sincere heart**, as you would Christ,

Colossians 3:22 Bondservants, obey in everything those who are your earthly masters, not by way of eye-service, as people-pleasers, but **with sincerity of heart**, fearing the Lord.

1 Timothy 1:5 The aim of our charge is **love that issues from a pure heart** and a good conscience and a sincere faith.

2 Timothy 2:22 So flee youthful passions and pursue righteousness, faith, love, and peace, along with those who call on the Lord **from a pure heart**.

Hebrews 3:8 **do not harden your hearts** as in the rebellion, on the day of testing in the wilderness,

Hebrews 3:12 Take care, brothers, lest there be in any of **you an evil, unbelieving heart**, leading you to fall away from the living God.

Hebrews 10:16 "This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, declares the Lord: I will put **my laws on their hearts**, and write them on their minds,"

Hebrews 8:2 a minister in the holy places, in the **true** tent that the Lord set up, not man.

Hebrews 9:24 For Christ has entered, not into holy places made with hands, which are copies of **the true things**, but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God on our behalf.

Matthew 5:8 "Blessed are the **pure in heart**, for they shall see God.

Matthew 15:8 "This people honors me with their lips, but their **heart is far from me**;

Matthew 15:18 But what comes out of the mouth **proceeds from the heart**, and this defiles a person.

Romans 1:21 For although they knew God, they did not honor him as God or give thanks to him, but they became futile in their thinking, and **their foolish hearts were darkened**.

2 Corinthians 4:6 For God, who said, "Let light shine out of darkness," has **shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God** in the face of Jesus Christ.

Psalms 24:3 Who shall ascend the hill of the LORD? And who shall stand in his holy place? ⁴ **He who has clean hands and a pure heart**, who does not lift up his soul to what is false and does not swear deceitfully.

2 Timothy 1:12 which is why I suffer as I do. But I am not ashamed, for I know whom I have believed, **and I am convinced** that he is able to guard until that Day what has been entrusted to me.

Colossians 2:2 that their hearts may be encouraged, being knit together in love, to reach all **the riches of full assurance of understanding** and the knowledge of God's mystery, which is Christ,

1 Thessalonians 1:5 because our gospel came to you not only in word, but also in power and in the Holy Spirit and **with full conviction**. You know what kind of men we proved to be among you for your sake.

Hebrews 6:11 And we desire each one of you to show **the same earnestness to have the full assurance of hope** until the end,

Ezekiel 36:25-26 **I will sprinkle clean water on you**, and you shall be clean from all your uncleannesses, and from all your idols I will cleanse you. ²⁶ **And I will give you a new heart, and a new spirit I will put within you. And I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh.**

Exodus 29:21 Then you shall take part of the blood that is on the altar, and of the anointing oil, and **sprinkle it on Aaron and his garments, and on his sons and his sons' garments with him**. He and his garments shall be holy, and his sons and his sons' garments with him.

Hebrews 12:24 and to Jesus, the mediator of a new covenant, and to **the sprinkled blood that speaks a better word** than the blood of Abel.

Hebrews 9:13 For if the blood of goats and bulls, and **the sprinkling of defiled persons with the ashes of a heifer, sanctify for the purification of the flesh**,

Hebrews 9:19 For when every commandment of the law had been declared by Moses to all the people, he took the blood of calves and goats, with water and scarlet wool and hyssop, and **sprinkled both the book itself and all the people**

Hebrews 9:21 And in the same way **he sprinkled with the blood** both the tent and all the vessels used in worship.

Hebrews 9:9 (which is symbolic for the present age). According to this arrangement, gifts and sacrifices are offered that **cannot perfect the conscience of the worshiper**,

Hebrews 9:14 how much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without blemish to God, **purify our conscience** from dead works to serve the living God.

Hebrews 10:2 Otherwise, would they not have ceased to be offered, since the worshipers, having once been cleansed, would no longer have **any consciousness of sins**?

Hebrews 13:18 Pray for us, for we are sure that **we have a clear conscience**, desiring to act honorably in all things.

1 Peter 3:21 Baptism, which corresponds to this, now saves you, not as a removal of dirt from the body but as **an appeal to God for a good conscience**, through the resurrection of Jesus Christ,

1 John 3:19 By this we shall know that we are of the truth and **reassure our heart before him**;

1 Timothy 1:5 The aim of our charge is **love that issues from a pure heart** and a good conscience and a sincere faith.

Ezekiel 36:25 I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you shall be clean from all your uncleannesses, and from all your idols I will cleanse you.

Exodus 29:4 You shall bring Aaron and his sons to the entrance of the tent of meeting and wash them with water.

Exodus 30:20 When they go into the tent of meeting, or when they come near the altar to minister, to burn a food offering to the LORD, they shall wash with water, so that they may not die.

Ephesians 5:26 that he might sanctify her, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the word

1 Corinthians 6:11 And such were some of you. But you were washed, you were sanctified, you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and by the Spirit of our God.

2 Corinthians 7:1 Since we have these promises, beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from every defilement of body and spirit, bringing holiness to completion in the fear of God.

Titus 3:5 he saved us, not because of works done by us in righteousness, but according to his own mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewal of the Holy Spirit,

Numbers 8:7 Thus you shall do to them to cleanse them: sprinkle the water of purification upon them, and let them go with a razor over all their body, and wash their clothes and cleanse themselves.

Hebrews 9:10 but deal only with food and drink and various washings, regulations for the body imposed until the time of reformation.

Hebrews 4:14 Since then we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus, the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession.

Hebrews 3:6 but Christ is faithful over God's house as a son. And we are his house if indeed we hold fast our confidence and our boasting in our hope.

Hebrews 3:14 For we have come to share in Christ, if indeed we hold our original confidence firm to the end.

Hebrews 6:18 so that by two unchangeable things, in which it is impossible for God to lie, we who have fled for refuge might have strong encouragement to hold fast to the hope set before us.

Revelation 3:11 I am coming soon. Hold fast what you have, so that no one may seize your crown.

Ephesians 4:14 so that we may no longer be children, tossed to and fro by the waves and carried about by every wind of doctrine, by human cunning, by craftiness in deceitful schemes.

Hebrews 3:1 Therefore, holy brothers, you who share in a heavenly calling, consider Jesus, the apostle and high priest of our confession,

1 Timothy 6:12 Fight the good fight of the faith. Take hold of the eternal life to which you were called and about which you made the good confession in the presence of many witnesses.

1 Corinthians 1:9 God is faithful, by whom you were called into the fellowship of his Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.

Hebrews 3:6 but Christ is faithful over God's house as a son. And we are his house if indeed we hold fast our confidence and our boasting in our hope.

Hebrews 11:11 By faith Sarah herself received power to conceive, even when she was past the age, since she considered him faithful who had promised.

Titus 1:2 in hope of eternal life, which God, who never lies, promised before the ages began

Hebrews 6:18-20 so that by two unchangeable things, in which it is impossible for God to lie,¹⁹ we who have fled for refuge might have strong encouragement to hold fast to the hope set before us. We have this as a sure and steadfast anchor of the soul, a hope that enters into the inner place behind the curtain,²⁰ where Jesus has gone as a forerunner on our behalf, having become a high priest forever after the order of Melchizedek.

Hebrews 11:11 By faith Sarah herself received power to conceive, even when she was past the age, since she considered him faithful who had promised.

v. 24

Hebrews 3:1 Therefore, holy brothers, you who share in a heavenly calling, fix your thoughts on/consider Jesus, the apostle and high priest of our confession

Hebrews 3:13

Colossians 3:16 Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God.

1 Thessalonians 5:11 Therefore encourage one another and build one another up, just as you are doing.

Acts 15:39 And there arose a sharp disagreement, so that they separated from each other. Barnabas took Mark with him and sailed away to Cyprus,

Hebrews 6:1 Therefore let us leave the elementary doctrine of Christ and go on to maturity, not laying again a foundation of repentance from **dead works** and of faith toward God,

Hebrews 9:14 how much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without blemish to God, purify our conscience from **dead works** to serve the living God.

Hebrews 6:10 For God is not unjust so as to overlook **your work and the love** that you have shown for his name in serving the saints, as you still do.

Titus 3:8 The saying is trustworthy, and I want you to insist on these things, so that those who have believed in God may be careful to devote themselves to **good works**. These things are excellent and profitable for people.

Ephesians 2:10 For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for **good works**, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.

v. 25

ἐγκαταλείποντες

Hebrews 13:5 Keep your life free from love of money, and be content with what you have, for he has said, "I will never leave you nor **forsake you**."

ἐπισυναγωγὴν

Matthew 18:20 For where two or three are **gathered in my name**, there am I among them."

Acts 2:1 When the day of Pentecost arrived, **they were all together** in one place.

1 Corinthians 11:20 **When you come together**, it is not the Lord's supper that you eat.

Psalms 55:14 We used to take **sweet counsel together**; within God's house we walked in the throng.

Acts 2:42 And they devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and the **fellowship**, to the breaking of bread and the prayers.

καθὼς ἔθος τισίν

John 19:40 So they took the body of Jesus and bound it in linen cloths with the spices, **as is the burial custom** of the Jews.

Acts 28:17 After three days he called together the local leaders of the Jews, and when they had gathered, he said to them, "Brothers, though I had done nothing against our people or the **customs of our fathers**, yet I was delivered as a prisoner from Jerusalem into the hands of the Romans.

παρακαλοῦντες

Hebrews 3:13 But **exhort one another** every day, as long as it is called "today," that none of you may be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin.

Hebrews 13:19 **I urge you** the more earnestly to do this in order that I may be restored to you the sooner.

Hebrews 13:22 **I appeal to you**, brothers, bear with my word of exhortation, for I have written to you briefly.

Colossians 3:16 Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, **teaching and admonishing one another** in all wisdom, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God.

1 Thessalonians 4:18 Therefore **encourage one another** with these words.

1 Thessalonians 5:11 Therefore **encourage one another and build one another up**, just as you are doing.

Hebrews 10:37 For, "Yet a little while, and **the coming one will come and will not delay**;

Habakkuk 2:3 For still the vision awaits its appointed time; it hastens to the end-- it will not lie. If it seems slow, **wait for it; it will surely come; it will not delay**.

1 Corinthians 3:13 each one's work will become manifest, for **the Day** will disclose it, because it will be revealed by fire, and the fire will test what sort of work each one has done.

Romans 13:11 Besides this you know the time, that **the hour has come** for you to wake from sleep. For **salvation is nearer to us now** than when we first believed.

Hebrews 1:4 having become **as much** superior to angels as the name he has inherited is more excellent than theirs.

Hebrews 12:1 Therefore, since we are surrounded by **so great a** cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us,

Hebrews 9:14 **how much more** will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without blemish to God, purify our conscience from dead works to serve the living God.

Hebrews 11:25 He chose to be mistreated along with the people of God **rather than** to enjoy the pleasures of sin for a short time.

Hebrews 12:9 Besides this, we have had earthly fathers who disciplined us and we respected them. Shall we not **much more** be subject to the Father of spirits and live?

Hebrews 12:25 See that you do not refuse him who is speaking. For if they did not escape when they refused him who warned them on earth, **much less** will we escape if we reject him who warns from heaven.
