deny, repudiate, disown, disregard oneself, to refuse to give thought to or express concern
for, to disregard, to pay no attention to, to say 'no' to

ὀπίσω
after, to come after, follow

ἀράτω AAImp3sg. fr. αιρω
lift up and move from one place to another, take/carry
lit. take up ones cross, to be prepared to endure severe suffering, even to the point of
death

σταυρὸν
cross, method of execution

ἀκολουθεῖτω PAImp3sg. fr. ακολουθεω
follow, be disciple, obey

καθ' ἡμέραν
marker of temporal aspect, distributively, by day, day by day, every day

ἀπολέσει FAI3sg fr. απολλυμι
lose something that one already has or be separated from a normal connection, lose

ἀπολέση AAS3sg fr. απολλυμι
lose something that one already has or be separated from a normal connection, lose

ἕνεκεν
because of, on account of, for the sake of

σῶσαι AAInf. fr. σωζω
preserve or rescue, save from death, save one's own life

σώσει FAI3sg fr. σωζω
preserve or rescue, save from death, save one's own life

ὠφελεῖται PPI3sg. fr. ὠφελεω
to benefit, to do good, to be successful in accomplishing some goal

κερδήσας AAPtcpMSN fr. κερδαίνω
to acquire by effort or investment, to gain, to profit

ἀπολέσας AAPtcpMSN fr. απολλυμι
lose something that one already has or be separated from a normal connection, lose

ζημιωθείς AAPtcpMSN fr. ζημιωω
suffer damage and loss, with implication of hardship or suffering, suffer loss of something which one has previously possessed

ἐπαισχυνθῆ ADS3sg. fr. ἐπαισχυνθη
to experience a painful feeling or sense of loss of status because of some particular event or activity, be ashamed, to experience or feel shame or disgrace because of some particular event or activity

ἐπαισχυνθήσεται FPI3sg fr. ἐπαισχυνθη
to experience a painful feeling or sense of loss of status because of some particular event or activity, be ashamed, to experience or feel shame or disgrace because of some particular event or activity

V. 27

γεύσονται ADS3pl fr. γευομαι
to experience something, cognitively or emotionally, come to know something, fig. extension of 'taste', to experience, focusing on personal involvement

ἴδωσιν AAS3pl fr. εἶδον
fig. extension of 'to see', to experience something, cf. Jn 3:3, 36; 8:51
