Have **this mind**
among yourselves, which is yours
in Christ Jesus,

he was
in the form
of God,

who **did not count** equality with God =
a thing to be grasped,

⁷ but made himself = nothing,
taking the form
of a servant,
being born
in the likeness
of men.

⁸ And being found
in human form,
he humbled himself
by becoming obedient
to the point of death,
even death on a cross.

⁹ Therefore God has exalted him
highly
and bestowed the name
on him that is
above every name,

¹⁰ so that every knee should bow
at the name
of Jesus,
in heaven
and on earth
and under the earth,

¹¹ and every tongue confess
that Jesus Christ is Lord,
to the glory
of God the Father.
