2a

Look out  
for the dogs,

b

look out  
for the evildoers,

c

look out  
for those  
who mutilate the flesh.

3a

For we are the circumcision,

b

who worship  
by the Spirit of God

c

and glory  
in Christ Jesus

d

and put no confidence  
in the flesh--

4a

though I myself have  
reason  
for confidence  
in the flesh  
also.

b

If anyone else thinks  
he has reason  
for confidence  
in the flesh,

c

I have more:

5a (I am/was) circumcised  
on the eighth day,

b of the people  
of Israel,

c of the tribe  
of Benjamin,

d a Hebrew  
of Hebrews;

e a Pharisee

as to the law

6a a persecutor  
of the church

b as to zeal

blameless

as to righteousness  
under the law

7b But I had gain  
whatever

a I counted  
as loss  
for the sake  
of Christ

(gain)

8a Indeed I count everything  
as loss  
because of the surpassing worth  
of knowing Christ Jesus  
my Lord

b I have suffered the loss  
For his sake of all things

c and count them  
as rubbish

d in order that I may gain Christ

9a and (may) be found  
in him

b having not a righteousness  
of my own  
that comes  
from the law

c but that which comes  
through faith  
in Christ

d the righteousness  
from God  
that depends  
on faith--

10a that I may know him  
b and the power  
of his resurrection

c and may share his sufferings

d becoming  
like him  
in his death

11 that I may attain the resurrection  
by any means possible from the dead.
