

# Philemon 1-3 mws

## v. 1

δέσμιος

prisoner, of Christians and others in prison, cf. Eph 3:1, 4:1, 2 Tim 1:8  
a person who is under custody in prison, prisoner

ἀγαπητῷ

pertaining to one who is dearly loved, dear, beloved, prized, valued, cf v. 7, 9, 1:7, Eph 6:21

pertaining to one who or that which is loved, object of one's affection, one who is loved, beloved, dear

συνεργῷ

pertaining to working together with, helping, helper, fellow-worker, 'co-workers in the Kingdom of God'

one who works together with someone else, fellow-worker

## v. 2

συστρατιώτη

comrade in arms, fellow-soldier, of those who devote themselves to the service of the gospel; applied to certain of Paul's associates

one who serves in arduous tasks or undergoes severe experiences together with someone else – one who struggles along with, one who works arduously along with, fellow struggler

κατ'

denoting relationship to something, with respect to, in relationship to  
a marker of a specific element bearing a relation to something else, in relation to, with regard to

## v. 3

χάρις

a beneficent disposition toward someone, favor, grace, gracious care, goodwill, divine favor in fixed formulas at the beginning of letters, grace  
favorable attitude toward someone or something, favor, goodwill

εἰρήνη

state of well-being, peace, welfare and health, cf. 2:14, 15, 17; 4:3; 6:15, 23

set of favorable circumstances involving peace and tranquility, peace, tranquility
