  - A. First
    - 1. Command
      - a. do not forget my teaching,
      - b. but keep my commands in your heart,
    - 2. Promise
      - a. for they will prolong your life many years
      - b. and bring you prosperity.
  - B. Second
    - 1. Command
      - a. Let love and faithfulness never leave you;
      - b. bind them around your neck,
      - c. write them on the tablet of your heart.
    - 2. Promise
      - a. Then you will win favor
      - b. and a good name in the sight of God and man.
  - C. Third
    - 1. Command
      - a. Trust in the LORD with all your heart
      - b. and lean not on your own understanding;
    - 2. Promise
      - a. in all your ways you will know/acknowledge him,
      - b. and he will make your paths straight.
  - D. Fourth
    - 1. Command
      - a. Do not be wise in your own eyes;
      - b. fear the LORD and shun evil.
    - 2. Promise
      - a. This will bring health to your body
      - b. and nourishment to your bones.
  - E. Fifth
    - 1. Command
      - a. Honor the LORD with your wealth,
      - b. with the firstfruits of all your crops;
    - 2. Promise
      - a. then your barns will be filled to overflowing,
      - b. and your vats will brim over with new wine.
