

Rom. 11:33-36 mws

V. 33

ὦ

an exclamatory utterance, O, Oh, How!

βάθος

something nonphysical perceived to be so remote that it is difficult to assess, depth, 'depth (i.e. inexhaustibility) of the wealth

an extreme point on a scale of extent, extremely, 'how exceedingly great are God's riches, wisdom, and knowledge'

πλούτου

plentiful supply of something, a wealth, abundance, 'Of that which God or Christ possesses in boundless abundance'

a high point on any scale and having the implication of value as well as abundance, great, abundant, abundantly, greatly, extremely

σοφίας

the capacity to understand and function accordingly, wisdom, transcendent wisdom, wisdom of God, 'or in the measures intended to bring salvation to the believers'

the capacity to understand and, as a result, to act wisely, to be prudent, wisdom

γνώσεως

comprehension or intellectual grasp of something, knowledge, as possessed by God
the content of what is known, knowledge, what is known

ὥς

a relatively high point on a scale involving exclamation, how, very, how great, how much, intense, severe, cf. 10:15

ἀνεξεραύνητα

unfathomable, lit. 'unsearchable', of God's judgments, cf. Pr. 25:3, Jer. 17:9

impossible to search out or fully understand, unsearchable, unfathomable

pertaining to being impossible to understand on the basis of careful examination or investigation, impossible to understand, unfathomable, impossible to comprehend, "how impossible it is to understand his decisions and to comprehend his ways"

κρίματα

content of a deliberative process, decision, decree, 'also of the fixed purposes of divine grace' cf. Psa. 19:9, 119:75

the content of the process of judging, judgment, decision, evaluation, 'how impossible it is to understand his judgments' or '...his decisions'

ἀνεξιχνίαστοι

inscrutable, incomprehensible, of God's ways, cf. Eph. 3:8
pertaining to being impossible to understand on the basis of careful examination or investigation,
impossible to understand, unfathomable, impossible to comprehend, 'how impossible it is to
understand his decisions and to comprehend his ways

ὁδοὶ

course of behavior, way, way of life, of the whole way of life, from a moral and spiritual
viewpoint, the way, teaching in the most comprehensive sense
a customary manner of life or behavior, with probably some implication of goal or purpose, way
of life, way to live

ἔγνων

AAI3sg

fr. γινωσκω

to have come to the knowledge of, have come to know, know
to come to an understanding as the result of ability to experience and learn, to come to
understand, to perceive, to comprehend

νοῦν

way of thinking, mind, attitude, cf. 1:28, 12:2, result of thinking, mind, though, opinion, decree
a particular manner or way of thinking, way of thinking, disposition, manner of thought, attitude

σύμβουλος

advisor, counselor, quoting Isa. 40:13

one who gives advice, adviser, 'who knows the mind of the Lord? Who can be his adviser?'

προέδωκεν

AAI3sg

fr. προδιδωμι

to be beforehand in giving, give in advance, quoting Isa. 40:14
to give in advance of some other event, to give beforehand, to give in advance, to give first, 'who
has ever given (God) something first?', or 'who has ever given God something before God gave
something?'

ἀνταποδοθήσεται

FPI3sg

fr. ἀντιποδιδωμι

to practice reciprocity with respect to an obligation, repay, pay back, requite, 'it will be paid back
to him'

to pay something back to someone as the result of an incurred obligation, to repay, to pay back,
to give back, 'who has ever given him anything, so that he had to pay it back?'

ἐξ

marker denoting origin, cause, motive, reason, from, of the effective cause, by, because of
a marker of the source of an activity or state, with the implication of something proceeding from
or out of the source, from, by

δι'

marker of personal agency, through, by, of divine activity, of God

a marker of intermediate agent, with implicit or explicit causative agent, through, by

εἰς

marker of goals involving affective/abstract/suitability aspects, into, to

marker of persons benefited by an event, with the implication of something directed to them, for,
on behalf of

δόξα

honor as enhancement or recognition of status or performance, fame, recognition, renown, honor,
prestige

honor as an element in the assignment of status to a person, honor, respect, status
