1. Read Psalm 54
2. List whether it is a hymn, lament, or thanksgiving
3. List the formal features typical of that Psalm type which you find in this Psalm.  
You may do this in one of two ways
  - a. List the typical formal features and for each feature list/describe which parts of the Psalm (possibly a word or phrase, but much more likely a line, verse or group of verses) that demonstrate this feature and why you think this part fits in that category.
  - b. Go through the Psalm in order and as you come to a formal feature (possibly a word or phrase, but much more likely a line, verse or group of verses), list/describe which formal feature you think it is and why you think it fits in that category.
4. Read Psalm 54 again to double check for something you have missed.
