- I. (Introduction-) “My son,” [1a]
- II. (Series of Commands and Promises) [1b-10]
  - A. (First) [1-2]
    - 1. (Command) [1]
      - a. do not forget my teaching
      - b. but keep my commands in your heart
    - 2. (Promise) [2]
      - a. for they will prolong your life many years
      - b. and bring you prosperity
  - B. (Second) [3-4]
    - 1. (Command) [3]
      - a. Let love and faithfulness never leave you
      - b. bind them around your neck
      - c. write them on the tablet of your heart
    - 2. (Promise) [4]
      - a. Then you will win favor
      - b. and a good name in the sight of God and man
  - C. (Third) [5-6]
    - 1. (Command) [5]
      - a. Trust in the LORD with all your heart
      - b. and lean not on your own understanding
    - 2. (Promise) [6]
      - a. in all your ways you will know/acknowledge Him,
      - b. and He will make your paths straight
  - D. (Fourth) [7-8]
    - 1. (Command) [7]
      - a. Do not be wise in your own eyes;
      - b. fear the LORD and shun evil
    - 2. (Promise) [8]
      - a. This will bring health to your body
      - b. and nourishment to your bones
  - E. (Fifth) [9-10]
    - 1. (Command) [9]
      - a. Honor the LORD with your wealth,
      - b. with the firstfruits of all your crops;
    - 2. (Promise) [10]
      - a. then your barns will be filled to overflowing,
      - b. and your vats will brim over with new wine.
