

PTH 201 Mentor Report 2 (instructions)

Discussion Guidelines:

In the weeks ahead, the student and mentor will continue to meet and address the student's spiritual life. The student should initiate and direct the discussion to the extent that ensures all necessary topics are covered. The mentor is free to respond as they determine to be best according to Biblical wisdom and their desire for the student's well-being and spiritual growth. The student should be entirely open and honest about every issue (walking in the light and not hiding in the darkness). The mentor should provide a safe environment for the student to be completely forthcoming, while graciously probing if the student needs help in that area. The student will provide the mentor a copy of an article entitled "X-ray questions" as an aid to this discussion.

Discussion Points:

The following topics should be discussed (while not being limited to these topics):

- The weekly course material and how specifically the student is applying it to their lives (ongoing topic of discussion)
- Any issue or area that the student needs to address about their spiritual growth.
- The specific areas of the student's life where they need help, growth and victory.
- Areas of sin, idolatry and forgiveness in the student's life
 - Using the x-ray questions (or similar), the student will confess areas of sin in their lives and discuss finding forgiveness in Christ
 - The student will talk about those who have sinned against them and the process they have done or are doing to forgive this person(s).
 - The student will talk about idols that function as gods in their life.
 - The mentor will help the student to find and properly diagnose their functional gods and how they compete with their professed God and how that causes specific sins in their life.
- The resources of Christ and His Gospel
 - Talk about the Gospel and how Jesus Himself is superior satisfaction compared to the functional idols and the true answer for all the student's desires and problems.
 - Talk about how the student can daily apply the Gospel to overcome the influence of these idols in their lives.
- The mentor and student should pray together about these issues.
