

EE7 – Arcing

Due Thursday July 21st.

Make an arc of your Philippians passage.

1. Use your sentence flow as the starting point for dividing propositions and beginning grouping. (Please turn in a copy of your sentence flow with this assignment so I know which propositions you are showing in your arc).
2. Use the arcing method you have learned in class and the symbols from the handouts to describe the relationships between the propositions in your passage.
3. Continue arcing until you have one large arc that describes the entire passage.

Restate the flow of thought in the passage in your own words.

1. Start with the main ideas and their relationships
e.g. “Paul commands us to... and the reason he gives for doing this is...”
2. Then describe the smaller relationships
e.g. “His reason has two parts: the negative reason... and the positive...”
3. An outline is often a great way to do this, but it is not mandatory that you use an outline form.
4. Make sure your restatement communicates two things:
 - a. What each proposition says in your own words
 - b. How the propositions relate together.
