

EE1 – English Grammar Review

1. Read the English Grammar review on the course website in its entirety.
 - a. Directions to the website are in your syllabus under ‘Helpful Hints’
 - b. The Grammar Review can be found by pulling down the ‘Reviews’ menu.
 - c. Read each page by navigating via the tabs at the bottom of the page.
2. *The last page of the review is a summary of the grammatical features discussed*
3. Find an example of items listed *in summary* numbers 2, 3, 4, 5, 9, 10, 11, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 19, 21, and 22 in the Bible (OT or NT). **NOTE:** These numbers refer to the listing on the last summary page, not to the page numbers themselves.
4. For each item:
 - a. List the chapter and verse number(s)
 - b. List the grammatical label from the summary
 - c. Write out the verse or part of the verse and somehow indicate which word or words is an example of this grammatical feature.

Example:

Item #7

- a. John 3:16
- b. Noun
- c. “God so loved the world” (nouns underlined)

Note: You may NOT use any verses which have been used as examples in handouts, on the website or in classroom discussions.
